PRIVACY STATEMENT

SECTION 1 - WHAT DO WE DO WITH YOUR INFORMATION?

When you use our product, as part of the use of our product, we collect the personal information you give us such as your name, address, email address, and other data.

When you use our software product, we also automatically receive your computer's internet protocol (IP) address in order to provide us with information that helps us learn about your browser and operating system.

Email marketing (if applicable): With your permission, we may send you emails about our us, our new products and other updates.

Data policy (if applicable): With your permission, we may collect your data for use in research and development of our products.

SECTION 2 - CONSENT

How do you get my consent?

When you provide us with personal information through registration, we imply that you consent to our collecting it and using it for that specific reason only.

When you provide us with any data through usage of our product, we imply that you consent to our collecting it and using it for that specific reason only unless you opt-in to additional usage of that data. When you opt-in to additional usage of data, such as affective data pertaining to the emotional content in text, we require you to explicitly agree to the use of that data for research and development.

If we ask for your personal information or data for a secondary reason, like marketing, we will either ask you directly for your expressed consent, or provide you with an opportunity to say no.

How do I withdraw my consent?

If after you opt-in, you change your mind, you may withdraw your consent for us to contact you, for the continued collection, use or disclosure of your information, at anytime, by contacting us at contact@alphanex.us. You may also withdraw your consent on the settings page of a digital product.

SECTION 3 - DISCLOSURE

We may disclose your personal information if we are required by law to do so or if you violate our Terms of Service.

SECTION 4 - THIRD-PARTY SERVICES

Our product is hosted on Amazon AWS and by various other hosting service providers, such as app stores. They provide us with the online services that allows us to provide our products and services to you.

Your data is stored through the data storage, databases and the application we which are hosted by these third parties. They store your data on a secure server protected by their means and abilities.
